Breeding Doe/Wether Dams Rules

The show is open to 4-H and FFA members from all states.

1. Showmanship –Students will show by grade as of what grade they are in the day of the show.
Class 1- 2nd grade and under Novice Division
Class 2-3rd-6th grade Junior Division
Class 3-7th-10th grade Intermediate Division
Class 4-11th grade-21 years of age Senior Division

(If classes are too big, we will break into heats, but only place 10

2. Does will be weighed when they arrive at the show and placed in a weight division. We will show in Light Weight, Medium Weight, and Heavy Weight classes.

Premiums are based each year on sponsorships and will be given based on the amount raised.

3. Pens will be available on a first come first serve basis if the pigs are done.
4. The show will be held outside in panels under a tent-Bring chairs!
5. Goats must be clean and ready to show, there is a wash area available
6. The judges' decision is final in all classes.
7. No abusive behavior towards animal or person will be tolerated. Any parent or exhibitor found in violation will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately.
8. All animals must be in good health
9. No power will be available. Bring a generator if needed.
10. Food Vendors will be on site
11. No dogs allowed!
12. Please follow the CDC guidelines for COVID-19, Flu, and RSV. The health and safety of our exhibitors and their families are of utmost concern. Please help us all stay safe and healthy by observing the following practices recommended by the CDC: IF YOU HAVE A COUGH OR FEVER OR ARE CONSIDERED HIGH RISK: PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE SHOW GROUNDS. WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN. MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE.
13. TAKE IT TO THE TRASH! Please be personally responsible for disposing of all items you touch (i.e.: tissues, paper towels, beverage cans and bottles).
14. No Smoking or Tobacco Products are allowed on our school premises.
15. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own goat in class. If the exhibitor has more than one goat in class, they can have another exhibitor show for them. However, the substitute exhibitor must already be entered in the show.
16. Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship that they are entered in the show with.
17. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
18. All goats must be ear tagged with the identification number entered on the entry form.
19. Limited space and pens are available. You are encouraged to show off your trailers. Please bring your own power source and no shavings will be provided.

20. A certificate of Veterinary inspection is required with the individual's identification. For out of state exhibitors a CVI is required.
21. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
