JUNIOR DAIRY HEIFER SHOW

Rules and Regulations:

- The Dairy Heifer Show starts at 3:00 am on Saturday, March 2, 2024. Dairy heifers must be in place by 2:30pm on the day of the show and will be released at the completion of their breed show.
- 2. Expected breed classes will be Holstein, Guernsey, Jersey, and Brown Swiss.
- 3. Animals must be shown by his/her owner in Showmanship classes.
- 4. We will show animals clipped and cleaned.
 - 5. The judges' decision is final in all classes.
 - No abusive behavior towards animal or person will be tolerated. Any parent or exhibitor found in violation will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately.
 - 7. All animals must be in good health
 - 8. No pens or power will be available.
 - 9. Only show officials and exhibitors are allowed in the show ring.
 - 10. Show officials reserve the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the show officials are final.
 - 11. If you are from out of state Health Papers are required!
 - 12. You will be stalling to your trailers
 - 13. Bring generators and tents
 - 14. Bedding will not be provided
 - 15. Food Vendors will be on site
 - 16. There will be access to water and a wash rack, but try to come ready to show
 - 17. The show will be held outside in panels under a tent
 - 18. No dogs allowed!
 - 19. Please follow the CDC guidelines for COVID-19, Flu, and RSV. The health and safety of our exhibitors and their families are of utmost concern. Please help us all stay safe and healthy by observing the following practices recommended by the CDC: IF YOU HAVE A COUGH OR FEVER OR ARE CONSIDERED HIGH RISK: PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE SHOW

GROUNDS. WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN. MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCE.

Dairy Classes:

Showmanship –Students will show by grade as of what grade they are in the day of the show.

D1: Pee Wee Showmanship: No premiums just ribbons-they can have help in the ring.

- D2: 2nd grade and under Novice Division (Unassisted) No help in the ring
- D3: 3rd-6th grade Junior Division
- D4: 7th-10th grade Intermediate Division
- D5: 11th grade-21 years of age Senior Division

(If classes are too big, we will break into heats, but only place 10)

Entries will be listed in order of age (youngest to oldest) and will be led into the show ring in order of class order. Classes will be made up after cattle have been checked-in at the show with no more than 10 head in any class.

Premiums are based each year on sponsorships and will be given based on the amount raised.
