Show Rules and Information

- Registration opens at 9:00 am. To register, bring completed Entry Form to the announcement platform and enter your info on each class sign-up sheet. Please allow approx. 10-15 min. to complete registration.
- 2. Show begins promptly at 10:00 am.
- Concessions will be available on the grounds. The grounds are spacious so bring your canopy and chairs. NO smoking, alcohol or dogs are allowed anywhere on the grounds, including the trailer parking area.
- 4. Champion and Reserve riders in each division will receive awards. Division class numbers are indicated at the bottom of the Rules.
- 5. Classes can be entered for \$5.00 per class, non-judged, with no payback.
- 6. Horse/Rider Combo can only show in 1 age division.
 - a. Walk/Trot: Riders cannot enter into any other classes requiring a canter, lope or gallop. Breaking gait will result in a "no time" and disqualification.
 - b. Youth: Riders must be 5-18 years of age.
 - c. Open: Riders must be 5 years or older.
- 7. Age of rider is determined as of 1-1-24 for classes and helmet requirements.
- 8. All riders must be prepared to present a current negative "Coggins" for each horse on the grounds. If a horse is from out of state, a current health certificate must be presented.
- 9. All youth riders must have a waiver form signed by parent.
- 10. All youth riders under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 11. All riders and handlers must wear long sleeved shirts, boots, and helmets. Helmets are required for all riders under 18 years of age. Riders 18 years of age and older may waive this requirement by signing a release at the show office. See Policy on Headgear Safety Equipment.
- 12. Stallions may only be shown by adults and must be under full control at all times.
- 13. Judge's decisions are final.
- 14. The event is open to all breeds, all ages of horse and rider
- 15. All tack must be safe and proper for discipline. All riders will be checked for safety before entering the arena or course
- 16. Horses showing major signs of lameness will be excused
- 17. Be aware that hunt dog trials may be occurring at the same time with dogs that are unrestrained on the property and/or gunfire that can be heard from the arena
- 18. A fall of horse and rider, at any time during the judging will be considered as out of the competition.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS AND VOLUNTARY CONSENT AGREEMENT THIS AGREEMENT (hereinafter, "Agreement") MUST BE CAREFULLY READ AND SIGNED IN CONSIDERATION OF my ability to participate, provide services for, conduct, prepare for or participate in any livestock and equine events or affiliated activities leading up or related to, or otherwise attend or be present at the SC Governor's School for Agriculture at John de la Howe (hereinafter, the "Events") (and hereinafter, collectively, the "Activities"). The undersigned, on behalf of himself/herself, his/her personal representative, heirs, and next of kin (hereinafter collectively, the "UNDERSIGNED") hereby: . WAIVER AND RELEASE: UNDERSIGNED hereby RELEASES, WAIVES, AND FOREVER DISCHARGES, the SC Governor's School for Agriculture at John de la Howe (and its owner, employees, volunteers, affiliates and subsidiaries) or any subdivision thereof, any promoter, participant, livestock/equine association, grounds operator, arena owner, officials, sponsors, advertisers (in each case associated in any way with any of the Events), owners and lessees of the premises used to conduct the Event(s), insurers, underwriters, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions or instructions or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the Event(s), and each of their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliated corporations and entities, shareholders, officers, directors, managing agents, employees, independent contractors, members, agents, and all other persons or entities participating or involved in the Events (hereinafter collectively, the "RELEASEES"), from any and all actions, causes of action, claims, suits, debts, dues, sums of money, bonds, bills, balances, losses, costs, expenses, damages, covenants, agreements, commitments, undertakings, promises, liabilities, obligations, lawsuits, judgments, orders and demands whatsoever, in law, at equity or otherwise, of whatever kind or nature, whether known or unknown, suspected or unsuspected, asserted, accrued, unaccrued, actual, contingent, or otherwise, direct or indirect and whether or not concealed or hidden arising out of, on account of or relating to any INJURY TO OR RESULTING IN DEATH of the UNDERSIGNED arising out of or related to any of the UNDERSIGNED's Activities (hereinafter, the "RELEASED CLAIMS"). The UNDERSIGNED covenants that the UNDERSIGNED shall not directly or indirectly, bring, commence, institute, maintain, prosecute, aid or fund in any way any action of any kind or otherwise assert against any of the RELEASEES anywhere in the world any Released Claim. 3. INDEMNITY AND HOLD HARMLESS: UNDERSIGNED hereby agrees to DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS, to the fullest extent permitted by law, the RELEASEES from losses, liabilities, obligations, claims, damages, settlements, injunctions, suits, actions, proceedings, demands, charges, fines, penalties, costs and expenses of every kind and nature, including reasonable fees, expenses and disbursements of attorneys, accountants and other professionals imposed upon, asserted against or incurred by any RELEASEE in connection with, arising out of or relating to (i) any Released Claim or (ii) the UNDERSIGNED's Activities, in each of (i) and (ii),

whether caused by the ordinary negligence of the RELEASEES or otherwise and including and/or arising out of UNDERSIGNED's improper and/or tortious conduct in connection therewith. UNDERSIGNED acknowledges that he or she has been informed that his or her PERSONAL SAFETY CANNOT BE GUARANTEED. UNDERSIGNED acknowledges that his or her participation in the Activities are completely voluntary, and he or she believes that the potential benefits of participation and/or services provided outweigh the risk and danger associated with Activities. UNDERSIGNED acknowledges that THIS AGREEMENT IS INTENDED TO BE FULLY SEVERABLE, and that if any portion of this Agreement is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance the Agreement shall continue in full legal force and effect. That shall include modifying the Agreement to allow the remainder of claims to be waived, released, and indemnified against if the inclusion of any claim is found to be invalid or contrary to public policy. This Agreement is to be interpreted and enforced under the laws of the state of South Carolina. UNDERSIGNED hereby accepted all terms set forth herein and acknowledges this is the complete agreement between the parties regarding these issues, and UNDERSIGNED agrees and acknowledges that NO ORAL REPRESENTATIONS, STATEMENTS, OR INDUCEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE APART FROM THIS AGREEMENT. UNDERSIGNED HAS COMPLETELY READ BOTH PAGES OF THIS AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTANDS ITS TERMS, AND UNDERSTANDS THAT THIS IS AN IMPORTANT LEGAL DOCUMENT AFFECTING SUBSTANTIAL LEGAL RIGHTS. UNDERSIGNED SIGNS THIS DOCUMENT FREELY AND VOLUNTARILY WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT, ASSURANCE, OR GUARANTEE BEING MADE TO HIM OR HER AND UNDERSIGNED INTENDS HIS OR HER SIGNATURE TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW.
