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Rabbit/Pocket Pet Rules

Showmanship – Students will show by grade as of what grade they are in the day of the show.

- **Class 1:** 2nd grade and under – **Novice Division Rabbit**
 - **Class 2:** 3rd – 6th grade – **Junior Division Rabbit**
 - **Class 3:** 7th – 10th grade – **Intermediate Division Rabbit**
 - **Class 4:** 11th grade – 21 years of age – **Senior Division Rabbit**
 - **Class 5: Pocket Pets-** You will show in Novice, Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Divisions for placings and then top 4 will compete for One Overall Showmanship Champion.
 - **Premiums are based each year on sponsorships and will be given based on the amount raised.**
 - Best in Breed will be awarded for each breed and one best in show overall will be selected for Rabbits.
 - One Grand Champion Pocket Pet will be selected.
1. The judges' decision is final in all classes.
 2. No abusive behavior towards animal or person(s) will be tolerated. Any parent or exhibitor found in violation will be asked to leave the show grounds immediately.
 3. The animal must be shown by the exhibitor.
 4. There will be a health check before any rabbits can come into the show tent. Do not bring your rabbits/pocket pets into the tent until they have been checked by a member of the committee. All animals must be in good health.
 5. Tattoos are encouraged, but not required. There will be somebody on site available to tattoo your rabbit.
 6. No power will be available.
 7. Show officials reserve the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the show officials are final.
 8. Food and drink vendors will be on site.
 9. There will be access to water, but we encourage you to come ready to show.
 10. The show will be held indoors.
 11. No dogs allowed!
